


## NSW Senior Secondary Student Concession Cards -2011

NSW senior secondary student concession cards for the year 2011 are being issued to all schools for distribution to students.

These cards are to be recognised for travel immediately.

The 2011 card is **Blue** in colour and the transport identifier (security foil) is **Silver**.

*Note: the card is not valid unless all details are completed and the current transport identifier is attached.*


NSW senior secondary student concession cards with 2010 Gold transport identifiers are to be recognised up to 31 March 2011.

## NSW Tertiary Student Concession Cards - 2011

This year's RailCorp tertiary student concession card is **BLUE** in colour and the transport identifier (security foil) is silver.

RailCorp cards are not valid unless all details are completed, including an expiry date, and a **current transport identifier** (silver foil) **is attached**.

Student identification cards issued to students by educational institutions (see sample) **will vary** for each educational institution, but they **must have valid transport identifiers** attached to or embedded in the card to be valid for concession travel.

**Note:** cards with **2010 Gold** transport identifiers are still to be recognised for concession travel until the expiry date shown on the card. If there is no expiry date on the card, it will be valid until 31 March 2011.

## NSW Proof of Age Concession Cards - 2011

The card is white in colour with red bands and the text is black.

These cards are to be recognised for travel immediately and are valid until the holder's sixteenth birthday which is shown on the bottom right hand side of the card.

*Note: The card **does not** require a concession transport identifier (security foil) to be attached but is only valid when all details have been completed and the card has been signed by the holder and is stamped with a school/issuing office stamp.*
